Entry Regulations

1. General information

The number of entries is not limited. Applicants have to fill in the entry form that is relevant to the category of the film they wish to enter to the competition. In accordance with the Festival's specialty, in the short film categories only productions made after or in 2015 may be entered, with the filmmaker (director) being under the age of 35 when making the film. In the long feature film category there is no such age limit.

Please note that the Festival accepts entries in the following categories: long feature, short feature and CineNewWave (special category for young Hungarian directors of short features and animations, therefore entry regulations for this category is not included in this document).

Entry fee:

- no entry fee is required in the categories of long features
- short features can only be entered via www.reelport.com by paying 10 EUR entry fee online

PLEASE NOTE: The Jameson CineFest screens only Hungarian premieres.

We can only accept films that have not been applied for, screened at any festivals, televisions or cinemas in Hungary before.

Pre-premieres, test and press screenings or any forms of free, open-access screenings are regarded as disqualifiers. (Exclusive cast premieres are exceptions to the rule)

In the case of withdrawal after the entry deadline or cancellation of the program the Festival is entitled to ask for indemnity.

The Hungarian and non-English international films must be subtitled in English. The official languages of the Festival are Hungarian and English, so any written documents should be sent either in English or in Hungarian.

The Festival will not pay any rental or screening fee.

The pre-jury of the Festival selects the films for the official screenings. **Please note that we DO NOT SEND ENTRY COPIES BACK**, all entered films are saved in the Festival's archive.

The filmmakers will be notified on the pre-jury's decision by e-mail by the 1st of August, 2017 the latest. The festival copies of the films selected for the festival program must arrive to our office by the 1st of September, 2017 the latest.

The decision of the pre-jury and the jury are definitive, no appeal lies after it.

The organizers do everything in their power to provide accommodation for the filmmaker(s) (maximum 2 persons) on the day of the film's premier and on one additional day (all together for two nights).

2. Entry

Entries are accepted in the following categories

Long feature films (60 minutes or longer)

To enter a long feature film the entry form at the www.cinefest.hu shall be downloaded and filled out completely. The form and the entry copy shall be sent to the Festival via post or online.

Electronic entry:

Please download the entry form, fill it out, sign it and send a scanned copy to office@cinefest.hu. The entry copy of the film shall be made available via video-sharing website (e.g. YouTube, vimeo). Please make sure that the link provided is valid up to the 15th of August 2017 and that you send us the password to the link as well. Please also note that we cannot accept entries via file transfer programs (e.g. WeTransfer).

Postal entry:

The entry form shall be sent together with all the annexes to the postal address provided in point 6. The entry copy of the film is to be sent on a DVD (with English subtitle). Please make sure to notify us in case it's not a PAL DVD.

Attachments required for a valid entry:

- *a short, 2-minutes scene from the film* (on the DVD of the entry copy in a separate file or via video-sharing website))
- *trailer* (on the DVD of the entry copy in a separate file or via video-sharing website)

And by e-mail to office@cinefest.hu:

- *English dialogue list* (with time codes in .srt or any other standard video subtitle file format)
- *photo of the director* (min. 5cm width, 300dpi., jpg format)
- *photo from the film* (min. 10 cm width, 300 dpi, jpg format, min. 3 snapshots)

The deadline for entry is May 31, 2017. By this date the entry form, the entry copy and ALL the necessary documents (see attachment requirements) must arrive to the Festival office via mail or in electronic form. Entries arriving after the deadline cannot be accepted.

No entry fee is required when entering a long feature.

Short feature films (shorter than 30 minutes)

Short features **may only be entered** to the Festival via www.reelport.com (by clicking on the Festival's logo). An entry fee of 10 EUR has to be paid online at the reelport site. To have a valid entry please fill out the datasheet at www.reelport.com. Please note that the

organizers may ask for additional data and documents if your film is selected for the Festival program.

The deadline for entry is May 31, 2017.

Entry fee: 10 EUR/film.

3. The entry form

Long features

When entering a long feature film please download and fill out the entry form available at www.cinefest.hu. Please use a word processor for filling out the entry form (e.g. Microsoft Word, Open Office, Pages, etc.)

We are not able to accept any entries unless all the required attachments are sent in electronic form AND we also received the entry copy (DVD) of the film.

We cannot accept any entries without a signed entry form.

Please fill out each and every line in the entry form. We are not able to accept entries in which any of the required information is missing.

How to fill out the entry form:

Technical specifications: please provide data on the screening copy of the film.

Brief synopsis: In order to publish the synopsis of the film in the Festival's catalogue we need a 150-250 character text.

IMPORTANT: Please note that if you fail to provide us with the required length of synopsis (e.g. you send a longer text) we will have to edit the text and the editing may not reflect the director's view of her/his film perfectly.

Short features

Please follow the entry regulations at www.reelport.com and fill out all required fields.

4. Screening of films selected for the Festival's competition program

Long feature films:

We kindly ask you to send us the screening copies in DCP/DCI or 35mm format. If both versions are available we prefer DCP/DCI. If the film selected into the competition section is not available in DCP/DCI or 35 mm format, Blu-ray might also be accepted.

Short feature films:

We kindly ask you to send us the screening copies of the films in the competition program on Blu-ray or in the best available digital format (Full HD, ProRes, etc.) via post to the address provided in Point 6 or in electronic form to office@cinefest.hu AND nagy.istvan@cinefest.hu. Please note that we cannot accept DCPs in these categories.

Subtitles:

English subtitles are needed for all non-English speaking films. The screening copy of the film must have fixed English subtitles. The English dialogue list shall be sent in all cases (even in the case of English speaking films) preferably with timecodes in a standard subtitle format (.srt, .stl, .ebu, .sub, etc.)

Please note that we do not translate and subtitle Hungarian films so no dialogue list is required to be sent. Screening copies of Hungarian films must have fixed English subtitles (or Hungarian subtitles if the spoken language is English or a mix of Hungarian and English).

If the screening copy is sent via post the sender shall *inform the Festival via e-mail* (office@cinefest.hu; kokai.nagy.timea@cinefest.hu) about the date and the way the copy of the film was sent, together with the reference or tracking number of the package. The films must be sent *prepaid*. In case the screening copy of the film is DVD or Blu-ray, the Festival does not send it back after screening, it becomes part of the Festival archive.

The films entered to the Festival will be screened at the venues of the Festival in the television magazine programs of the Festival as well as in shows promoting the events of the Festival. Jameson CineFest Miskolc International Film Festival reserves the right to use *parts of the film* for noncommercial purpose as a promotional material in different areas of media.

The Festival will not pay any rental or screening fee.

5. The protection of personal data

The organizers of the Festival will handle all personal data given to them in connection with the Festival entry confidential; they will use them only for the registration and the festival publications, not handing them over to any third person. Files uploaded at the www.reelport.com shall fall under the same regulations. Films uploaded to the website serve the purpose of pre-selection only. Films not selected for the Festival's official screening program will be deleted.
